

Addenda to Solicitations

Solicitations may have had Addenda issued to them. An Addendum in some way modifies information from the original solicitation, i.e., to announce changes in the opening date, specifications, terms, conditions, or modifications to the document or pricing sheet. In addition, many addenda are mandatory (MUST be signed and returned with the submittal). Failure to return a mandatory addendum may cause the submittal to be rejected.

Vendors who did not receive an e-mail notification of a solicitation listed on this site will not receive notification of Addenda on that solicitation. Vendors must ensure their registration is properly updated in order to receive the e-mail notifications. See the information on Vendor Registration for more information. Vendors who do not update their registration in order to receive the e-mail notifications shall be responsible for obtaining addenda information from this website.

It is the responsibility of all potential vendors to monitor this site for any changing information prior to submitting their reply.
